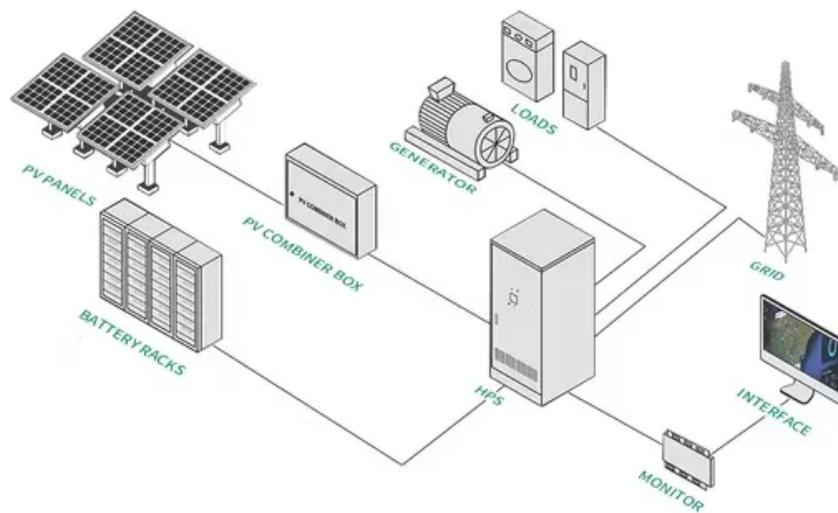


Ancient solar power generation sun room
