Overview

Yes, most new single-family homes and low-rise multifamily buildings must include a solar PV system per the 2025 Title 24 energy code. Are there any exemptions to the solar mandate?

Some homes may be exempt if they have limited roof space or are enrolled in approved community solar. Section 150.1(c)14 - PDF of the 2025 Energy Code requires solar photovoltaic (solar PV) systems or modules for all newly constructed single-family residential buildings, with five exceptions (see accordion describing exceptions below). California leads in renewable energy, committed to sustainable practices and reducing greenhouse gas emissions. This commitment is reflected in comprehensive. The California solar mandate is a state law that requires most new residential buildings to include rooftop solar. Title 24 of the California Energy Code locked this in back on Janu.

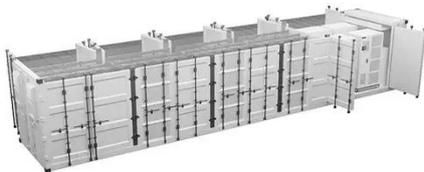


Title 24 Solar Requirements California , CA Green Energy


California Solar Mandate
