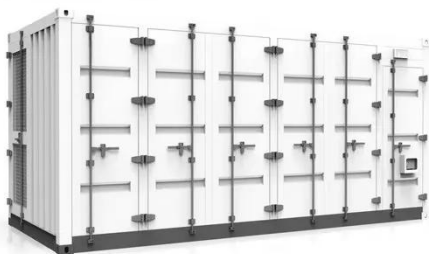


What Is a BMS Reset for Electric Vehicles? When and How to Do It

Press and hold the reset button on your battery to reboot the battery and the BMS. Wait thirty minutes after resetting the BMS before reinstalling it on your vehicle.

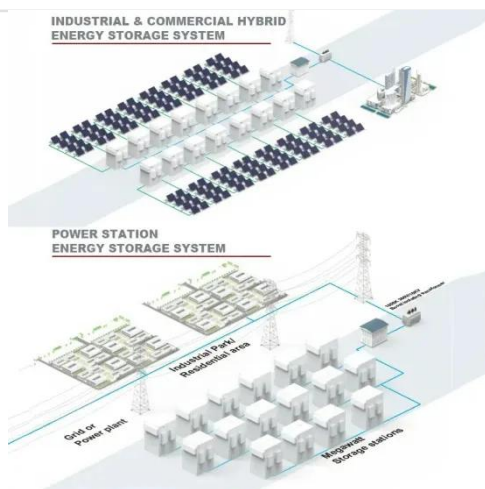

Upgrading to a bigger battery (low battery combat?)

The larger capacity would only tend to help the higher loads for a longer time interval. Remember, cranking takes a lot of power out in a short time that takes a lot of time to Charge back in.
