The Palestinian government seeks to develop the regulatory framework and policies and improve the sustainable energy sector, in cooperation with ministries and operating institutions, local authorities, private sector. Over the past 14 years, the legislative, regulatory, and institutional pillars of the electricity sector in Palestine have witnessed an extensive restructuring process until 2009, when the General Electricity Law in Palestine was enacted. On Octoless than 24 hours after Hamas carried out the October 7 attacks, Israel halted the flow of power to Gaza, instantly cutting the availability of electricity from 14 to four hours per day. Palestinians living with limited electricity in Nuseirat Refugee Camp in the central Gaza. Palestine's electricity sector faces unique challenges compared to its Middle Eastern neighbors. Approximately 87% of the country's electricity is imported from Israel, while the remaining 13% comes from Jordan, Egypt, and local solar PV plants, with solar contributing only about 5% of total.
