Overview

The European Union (EU) is strengthening its support for Tunisia's energy transition with €35.8 million in grant financing provided under the Neighbourhood Investment Platform (NIP), to accelerate the development of renewable energy generation and electricity infrastructure in the country. The EU. Cooperation on clean energy will be an important facet of the EU's "Pact for the Mediterranean", a new strategic initiative to connect the bloc with its neighbours in North Africa and beyond. Renewables are mainly used to generate electricity, though renewable technologies can also be used for heating in homes and buildings. In 2024, the energy dependency rate stood at 59%. Natural gas currently accounts for 94.145€, compared with a selling price set. TUNIS, Novem— The World Bank and the Government of Tunisia have concluded a financing agreement to support Tunisia's energy sector modernization agenda through the Tunisia Energy Reliability, Efficiency, and Governance Improvement Program (TEREG).


