

Tehran power outages



Overview

Iran has resumed four-hour daily power outages in Tehran and other cities as a severe energy crisis grips the country, the semi-official Tasnim news agency reported on Wednesday, sparking public complaints over unannounced cuts and unequal distribution. The blackouts, often split into two two-hour. A view of the electric poles as power cuts are occurring across the country, including in the capital, Tehran, Iran on Decem. Tehran's wealthy northern neighbourhoods face only 1 per cent of the city's blackouts, while the poorer southern districts endure 32 per cent of them. 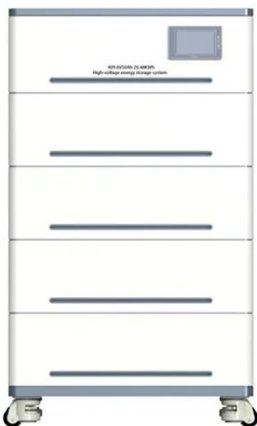
