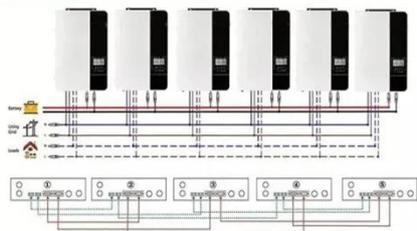




Parallel (Parallel operation up to 6 unit (only with battery connected))
